Chairman Glasnapp, called the meeting to order. All in attendance recited the Pledge of Allegiance. Motion by Hansen, second by Quastad to approve the minutes from last week's meeting also approving them for publication. All Ayes, motion carried.

During Public forum, Quastad and Pluth reported on their visit to the Iowa State Capitol last week. Legislators gave them the impression that they are working on the issue but it may be too late for the currently proposed pipelines. The Board discussed a potential pipeline moratorium as a course of action. The Board will not be meeting next week as they may be attending meetings that day at the Capitol regarding the proposed pipelines.

Schumacher requested that the appointment of Lexi Ruter to the Northwest Iowa Planning and Development Commission be put on the next meeting agenda.

Schumacher also indicated that the Estherville Area Partnership for Growth (EAPG) needs a representative due to the resignation of Jay Lausen. The Board thought they had appointed someone. Auditor Sathoff will verify the appointment.

Hansen shared an email she received regarding the Proposed Pipeline.

Glasnapp reported that the committee will start interviews for the Information Technology position next week.

Emmet County Engineer, Walter Davis-Oeth joined the meeting to discuss equipment transmission issues. He also reported that Secondary Roads has been receiving 911 address requests from the pipelines. It was the consensus of the Board was not to assign those email addresses at this time.

Davis-Oeth reported that he will be meeting with Farm Bureau next week.

At 9:33 a.m. the Board opened the Public Hearing on the proposed Peters Subdivision. Emmet County Zoning Administrator Barb Bohm and realtor Mike Clarken joined the meeting.

The Auditor's office did receive comment from the Estherville Planning and Zoning commission and the subdivision's proposed use is within the requirements of the Estherville Zoning Code and the Commission voted unanimously to recommend the request.

Clarken addressed access issues that the Board was concerned about.

Motion by Schumacher, second by Pluth to close the public hearing. Roll Call Vote: Ayes: Schumacher, Hansen, Pluth, Quastad and Glasnapp. Nays: None.

Motion by Pluth, second by Hansen to approve the proposed Peters Subdivision as presented. All ayes, motion carried.

Emmet County Zoning Administrator, Barb Bohm presented the Emmet County Planning & Zoning Commission recommendation on an ordinance amending various sections of the 2013 Emmet County Zoning Ordinance for the purpose of regulating and restricting the use of land for the transport of Hazardous liquid through a hazardous liquid pipeline.

The Board will meet with Ahler's & Cooney Attorney Whipple in closed session on February 28, 2023 at 9:15 a.m. Motion by Quastad, second by Schumacher to set the public hearing on the proposed Ordinance Amendment for March 7, 2023 at 10:30 a.m. All ayes, motion carried.

The Board reviewed the Treasurer's monthly report.

The Board reviewed the monthly claims. Motion by Schumacher, second by Pluth to approve the claims as presented. All ayes, motion carried.

Motion by Quastad, second by Pluth to approve the drainage claims as presented with a correction. All ayes, motion carried.
