Adoption of resolution 24-15 Certification of Canvass of Primary Election 2024. WHEREAS, the PRIMARY ELECTION was held as prescribed by law on June 4, 2024, and;

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors and ex officio Board of Canvassers have canvassed the vote of said election in accordance Iowa Code 43.49 and 50.24, now therefore;

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that we, the undersigned members of the Board of Supervisors and ex officio Board of Canvassers of Emmet County, Iowa, do hereby certify the following TURNOUT report and RESULTS in the PRIMARY ELECTION, held June 4, 2024, and that no obvious clerical errors were identified during the canvass.

Seven hundred three (703) people voted at the polls on election day. One hundred eighty-six (186) absentee ballots were accepted for counting. Zero (0) provisional ballots were accepted for counting. A total of eight hundred eighty-nine (889) people voted. Voter turnout 13.61%.
